Treasure's Report:

Unfinished Business:

We need to check with the school on what we made at the feed and if we got the gate for those games, in December. Believe we have money coming from these.

We ended up not cleaning the kitchen. The food group class had worked on this and cleaned drawers, shelves, etc.

Kicks Sports in Baker City has been great donating water for the concessions. We need a Thank You from the Booster Club and Junior Class.

Need to really gear up on some fund raisers to get the scorer's table.

New Business:

Cherry Fair will be coming up in August; Deb suggested maybe we could sell more items, other than t-shirts, seats, and membership. Possibly sell cherry aprons, pot holders, even pies and mini pies. Deb will check with Kathy to see what we might be allowed to sell.

Kindra Moore was there to present her Senior Project to us. She proposes to purchase a commercial ice machine for the school. One of the biggest hurdles is where to put it. She recommended 3 locations, the home ec room, the weight room, or the boiler room. The approximate cost is around \$1627.00. She would like monetary help from the booster club. Kindra was asked to submit an application for a funding request.

There was more discussion on memberships and renewals, how to encourage people to join. Anyone is welcomed to belong to the booster club. It would be nice to get back to having the membership breakfast in September. Get it back to being an annual event so everyone knows that it is coming.

Amy reported that Timur has gotten a new job in Irrigon. She will be gone all week long. After discussion, Darcy made the motion to remove Timur from Sec./Treas. and nominated Deb Hansen. Jean Anne seconded, passed unanimously.

The booster club has requested a rep from ASB to come to the meetings, to help keep the booster club informed of things going on in the school. No one has attended so far. Kelli Neil will write a letter to Lisa Murchison asking for help in this endeavor.

Drive 4 UR School will be March 7th at Legacy Ford in La Grande from 9am to 4pm. Kelli has sent flyers home with her class already. Deb will ask Kelsey to put a flyer out with the bulletin the 2 weeks before the event. It is \$20 a car and doesn't take very long to participate. It would be nice to be able to do a general mailer or something to let the whole community know. Tammy Robinson will contact the radio stations and the newspaper. Also let the public know that this is going to go towards the purchase of a new scorer's table. It might help for people to know exactly what the money will be used for.
