### **Committee Reports:**

**Scholarship:** Have sent copy of the updated application to the advisors to pass out. JeanAnne Dilworth, Nate Conrad, and Kelly Neil are on the scholarship committee.

### **Unfinished Business:**

**Drive 4 Ur School,** will be held March 7, 2015. Could not find the big banner, the school did have the smaller one they put on the fence. Mr. Miles will also have it put on the reader board and Deb will get hold of Kelsey to put it in the bulletin for school. Kelly Neil will attend the table at Drive 4 Ur School from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. Then Nate Conrad will do 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. Debra Hansen from 1 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. People who cannot make it and want to help we ask for \$20 donation. That is what we get per car driven.

**Flag-** The last \$2500 was paid to Pioneer West to finish the roll down flag. Greg Bingaman had the rest of the sponsor part for the back of the flag.

**By-Laws-** Will have a first reading of the bylaws at the April meeting.

Sports awards will be March 10<sup>th</sup> at 7 p.m.

There will be a need for someone to take over the 5K and 10K walk run during Cherry Festival that Mr. Sheehy used to do. Booster club will look into this further. \$20 and maybe we could give a t-shirt with each entry.

**Other Business:**

Discussed that booster club and the Jr. Class need to send Kicks Sports thank you for their donation of the water for concessions. Get thank you cards to them ASAP.

Motion made to adjourn the meeting, 2<sup>nd</sup>. Meeting adjourned.
